RING 1

OPEN JUMPING : Commencing 9.00am

Entry fee: £5 in advance or £6 on the day - Rosettes to 6th place & medal to class winners. All classes will be split between horses/ponies if entries warrant. Rosette for best placed CVFHPC member in each class.

Classes 1, 3, 5, 7, 9 and 11 will be run as two phase; ie, if clear over first part of course, you go straight into timed section.

Accumulator: one round against the clock with the 1st fence worth 1 point, 2nd fence worth 2 points etc. Winner is fastest clear or fastest with least amount of faults.

Accumulator: one round against the clock with the 1st fence worth 1 point, 2nd fence worth 2 points etc. Winner is fastest clear or fastest with least amount of faults.

CLEAR ROUND CROSS COUNTRY AND WORKING HUNTER CLASSES

PONY CLUB MEMBERS MUST WEAR BACK PROTECTION FOR XC

From 9am – 10 am: Clear Round Cross Country over various heights, from 1'6" upwards. Clear Round entries close 9.45 am.

Entry £2 per round. Rosettes for all clears.

10 am: Working Hunter Classes. Entry fee £5 in advance or £6 on the day.
Rosettes to 6th place, medals to class winners.

CLASS 30: Open Working Hunter, fences approx 2'6", for horses over 15hh

CLASS 31: Open Working Hunter, fences approx 2'3", for 15 hh and under

CLASS 32: Novice Introduction Working Hunter, fences approx 2'0", for horse/rider combination not to have been placed 1st, 2nd or 3rd in any Working Hunter class

CLASS 33: Assisted Working Hunter, fences approx 1'9", ponies 14 hh and under, riders 12 years and under

CLASS 34: Lead Rein Working Hunter, fences approx 1'6", ponies 13hh and under, riders 10 years and under

Classes 32, 33 and 34 will not be judged on turnout. The course will be a mixture of Jump4Joy plastic crosscountry fences, our mini crosscountry fences and rustic SJ.

Classes may be split, at judge's discretion, if numbers warrant.

Clear Round Cross Country may continue if time permits.

RING 6 Sponsored by Cabins UK
RIDDEN SHOWING FOR HORSES AND PONIES

Commencing 9 am. Entry £5 in advance or £6 on the day.

Rosettes to 6th place and medals to class winners.

Classes may be split, at judge's discretion, if numbers warrant.

CLASS 35: Best Turned Out, for horses over 14.2hh

CLASS 36: Best Turned Out, for ponies 14.2 hh and under

CLASS 37: Most suitable lead rein pony 12.2 and under, to be judged on manners and suitability. Riders 8 years and under. To be ridden in a snaffle bridle, lead rein to be attached to noseband.

CLASS 38: Most suitable child's pony, off lead rein, judged on manners and suitability. To be ridden in a snaffle bridle.

CLASS 39: Most suitable Riding Club horse, judged on manners and suitability. May be asked to jump a small fence. Need not be a member of a Riding Club.

Not before 1.30 pm

CLASS 40: Introduction to Showing. For those never to have been placed 1st, 2nd, 3rd or 4th in any showing class. Can use your normal riding bit and tack. An informal, encouraging class to get you started – have a go! Rosettes to all competitors.

CLASS 41: Most suitable Pony Club pony, judged on manners and suitability. May be asked to jump a small fence. Need not be a member of a Pony Club.

CLASS 42: Mountain and Moorland

CLASS 43: Veteran pony/horse over 16 years old

CLASS 44: Coloured pony/horse
