

## HEALTH AND SAFETY POLICY FOR THIS EVENT

1. The Organiser has overall responsibility for Health and Safety.
2. The event is organised in accordance with health and safety legislation and all who have (to any extent) control of premises or site at the event are responsible for ensuring that:
  - a) everything reasonably practicable is done to ensure health and safety and welfare of those attending the event.
  - b) they conduct themselves so that they do not put themselves or anyone else at risk
  - c) access to and egress from the site is safe
3. Emergencies-emergency services must have access to all parts of the event site at all times and members of the public must not park vehicles so as to obstruct access. First Aid points are clearly marked.

In case of emergency, members of the public should contact the nearest official or dial 999 on the nearest telephone.
4. Horses can easily be frightened and can be dangerous. Members of the public are requested to keep clear from horse areas/lanes and to avoid behaviour which might alarm horses.
5. Dogs **MUST** be on a lead and under close control at **ALL** times.

## RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. The Judge's decision is final
2. Legal Liability: neither the organisers nor any persons acting on their behalf accept any liability for loss, damage, accident or illness to ponies/horses, riders, spectators or any other persons or property.
3. The Committee reserves the right to alter or amend the schedule.
4. Any objections or protests must be handed into the Show Secretary in writing within 30 mins of the incident with a £20 deposit (which will be forfeited if objection is not upheld)
5. Hard hats to the standard acceptable to the British Riding Clubs (see their website) which must be worn and correctly fastened at all times whilst mounted.
6. All ages as on the day of the show
7. The Committee reserve the right to ask anybody to leave the show ground.

## **RING ONE - Starting 10:00**

- Class One** 2'3" show jumping  
**Class Two** 2'6" show jumping  
**Class Three** Accumulator (with Joker fence)  
**Class Four** 2'9" show jumping  
**Class Five** 3' - 3'3" show jumping  
**Class Six** 3'6" show jumping

Classes 1, 2 and 4 - will be split horse/ponies if sufficient entries

**Entry Fee Ring One:** £5 per combination per class

## **RING TWO**

**Clear Round Jumping.** Entry at ringside. **9:30 - 10:30**

Entry fee: £1 per round or £1.50 with rosette

**To follow Clear Round Jumping -**

- Class Seven** 1'6" show jumping - lead rein/assisted (split if sufficient entries)  
**Class Eight** 1'9" show jumping - assisted/alone (split if sufficient entries)  
**Class Nine** Accumulator  
**Class Ten** 2' show jumping  
**Class Eleven** 2'3" show jumping

Combinations in Classes 10 and/or 11 must not have competed in Class 7  
Competitors in Ring Two may only compete in Class 1 in Ring One

**Entry Fee Ring Two:** £4 per combination per class

Section A - lead rein or assisted

Section B - everybody else!

May be split Juniors (under 16 years) and Seniors (16 years and over) if entries warrant; age on day of show .

**Class Fourteen** Pick'n'Mix

A) Prelim test 12

B) Novice test 24
